The Women's Center

The MCSA Women's Center is designed as a family-centered addition to the campus dedicated to providing care for women and their children born in South Arkansas.

Two corridors connect the Women's Center to the main hospital with one providing access for public and support services and the other is a dedicated entrance to surgery on the second floor for necessary support for cesarean sections births.



Women's Center:

- 29,000 square feet total building area
- Reception area and waiting room on the ground floor
- Dedicated elevator for expectant mothers
- Five Labor, Delivery and Recovery Rooms
- Fourteen Postpartum Rooms
- Twelve-station Well-Baby Nursery
- Babies monitored at all times by infant security system
- Specialty Care Nursery-able to care for 1500 gram babies or greater or 32 week babies
- S.T.A.B.L.E. certification for all nursery nurses
- Staff trained in NPR (neonatal resuscitation program)
- Latest technologies in surveillance/monitoring
- Offer pediatric CPR to public
- Sibling classes
- Childbirth education classes
- OB nurses are all trained in Advanced Fetal Monitoring
- Lactation consultation for new moms
